TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday January 13, 2020

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Edwards were present.

-First public: A public Thank You to Tylor Hartwig for his years of service as our Plow Truck Driver.

-Agenda-There was a Steigerwaldt / Tomaszewski motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for December 2019 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$213,396.84. December deposits of \$794,168.37, withdraws of \$13,252.75, with an ending balance of \$994,312.46. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Minute's approval for the December 9 2019 regular town meeting. There was a Steigerwaldt/ Wiese motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Chairman Wiese received notification from Charter Communications that basic work on the internet construction will be completed on 1/10/2020. He was unsure how Charter would contact homeowners on the availability to hook-up to their homes.

NEW BUSINESS

-Wages for Town employees: During the process of trying to recruit a new snow plow truck driver and grader operator, Chairman Wiese encountered the realization that are pay was not in line with other such jobs. After some discussion, there was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to go from \$19.00 per hour to \$22.00 per hour for each position. All Ayes. Motion carried. It was also a discussion about Town employee wages. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to increase the Lead Worker position wages from \$14.00 to \$15.00 and to town maintenance workers from \$11.00 to 14.00 per hour. All aye.

-Approving Lincoln County Shoreland Zoning Ordinance amendments related to new boathouse size requirements to go from 300 sq. ft. to 450 sq. ft. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt to approve changes (Town of King resolution #2020-1). All ayes. Motion carried. Clerk to notify LC Land Services.

-Comments: any items not requiring Board action. A reprehensive from the Mable Lake Association informed the Board that they would be installing an aerator on the lake.

-Adjourn: There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to adjourn at 7:53pm.
