

**TOWN OF KING
TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday February 10, 2020

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Edwards were present.

-First public: The DNR no longer has a Fire Warden for the Town of King. You can get burning permits from either Cracker Barrel Gas Station on hwy. L, the DNR.wi.org website or call 1-888-947-2876.

-Agenda-There was a Steigerwaldt / Wiese motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for January 2020 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$994,312.46. December deposits of \$1,104,045.61, withdraws of \$768,656.02, with an ending balance of \$1,329,702.05. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Minute's approval for the January 13, 2020 regular town meeting. There was a Steigerwaldt/ Wiese motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Clerk received a letter from the Town of Skanawan that they have updated their comprehensive Plan ordinance. A copy can be found on Skanawan's website. A letter was received from Melinda Osterberg, the Community Development Educator from UW-Madison, advising people the importance of participating in the 2020 Census and what it means to each and every community. Everyone who spends 6 months + 1 day in the Town of King needs to be counted. The distribution of Federal Monies is directly related to these census numbers. Handouts will be available at town hall on Election Day (02/18/2020).

OLD BUSINESS – Charter/Spectrum installing connections to homes this month. Just a notice for anyone that may not be approached by Charter to call them. Frontier is available through telephone land lines, DSL internet. Call Frontier for information.

NEW BUSINESS

-Town Boundaries-Chairman Wiese will be attending a seminar on 03/18/2020 for more information how and when Town Boundaries are related to the town.
