TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday March 9, 2020

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Edwards were present.

-First public forum-brief concerns or questions: None

-Agenda-There was a Steigerwaldt / Wiese motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for February 2020 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$1,329,702.05. February deposits of \$157,404.73, withdraws of \$1,192,291.96, with an ending balance of \$294,814.82. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Minute's approval for the February 10, 2020 regular town meeting. There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Clerk received a card from the Lincoln County Humane Society thanking the town for there contribution. The quarterly newsletter was received from the North Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Comm. Clerk will have it on file at the Town Hall. OLD BUSINESS – The Town's new website to go live soon. The clerk no longer has access to the current website.

NEW BUSINESS

-Town Computer-The old town computer is available for purchase. Price to be determined.

-Creation of a Town Park- State Grant money may be available to create a park in townships. A couple of option sites were suggested. 1-The former landfill area off County Road A. 2-The Shorewood Circle area. It was suggested that maybe a couple of picnic tables be available. The question came up about restrooms. Board members will follow up on possible sites and how practical the idea is.

River Road & State Grant money-The town got notice this week that our 90/10 road grant application to resurface River Road was not granted. Supervisor Tomaszewski will follow up to see what grant money may be available for this Project.

-Spectrum event at Treehaven-By invitation only, Charter/Spectrum will be hosting an internet completion party for those involved with getting the grant for the Town of King. The event is scheduled for April 2, 2020 @ 2:00pm.

-Special recycling day for Town of King residents for electronics was brought up. Supervisor Tomaszewski will check what options and the costs associated with them are available. If available and affordable, a Spring or Early Summer timeframe was suggested.
