TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday April 13, 2020 – Done via teleconference

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Edwards were present.

-First public forum-brief concerns or questions: None

-Agenda-There was a Steigerwaldt / Tomaszewski motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers with on notation. Check issued to A. Tomaszewski for building materials for election screens was voided and check was correctly issued for the same amount to Menards. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for March 2020 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$294,814.82. March deposits of \$504.11, withdraws of \$33,291.71, with an ending balance of \$262,027.22. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Minute's approval for the March 9th, 2020 regular town meeting. There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Supervisor Tomaszewski reported that he had information on an Electronic Recycling Day which would probably be scheduled for June or July. He asked the issue be put on next months agenda.

OLD BUSINESS – Chairman Wiese brought the issue up about selling the old Town laptop computer. Clerk Edwards said she has a chance to look through it and it was not worth saving. Treasurer Allen reminded the importance of disposing correctly.

Clerk Edwards assured him that all extra election expenses were going into a separate account, and if it was determined that we could get reimbursed for them, everything would be in order.
