

**TOWN OF KING
TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday May 11, 2020 – Meeting via teleconference

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Edwards were present.

-First public forum-brief concerns or questions: Chairman Wiese reported that there was another dump of garbage on Lily Lane Road.

-Agenda-There was a Steigerwaldt / Tomaszewski motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: Clerk Edwards read the May vouchers to the board. E-mail transmission didn't work.

There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers as read. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for April 2020 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$262,027.22. April deposits of \$27,254.44, withdraws of \$17,302.08, with an ending balance of \$271,979.58. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Minute's approval for the April 13, 2020 regular town meeting. There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence:

OLD BUSINESS

– Electronics recycling day: Supervisor Tomaszewski reported that a dumpster from Eagle Waste would cost \$525.00 plus 0.33 per pound. Looking at a possible date in July or August.

NEW BUSINESS

-Town Road projects: Chairman Wiese met with Lincoln County Hwy. Dept. They quoted him \$3000.00 to \$4000.00 to patch Shorewood (with blacktop and rolling it) and \$101,360.00 to redo River Road and finish it with 2 ½" of blacktop. This years road budget is \$114,943.00. This will leave us just over \$9500.00 for needed gravel. There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to accept Lincoln County's proposal for River Road and Shorewood Road patch. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Additional costs for 2019/2020 plowing for Lake James Road. Due to pressure put on Chairman Wiese from 2 separate residents of Lake James Rd and against this recommendation, the grader was sent out on 4/13/2020 and got stuck. There are charges of \$918.95 for towing. There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to pass charges along to Lake James Road. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-Billing for 2019-2020 snow plowing season. Clerk Edwards expressed concern that not all plowing records for Private roads were turned in, therefore billing would be difficult. Chairman Wiese will contact drivers and get needed information.

- Taking care of town equipment. Chairman Wiese will instruct town employees what needs to be done to maintain town equipment. At the end of use, all equipment must be cleaned and gone over before storing. Comments: any items not requiring Board action; agenda items for the next Board meeting. A town resident expressed concern that edging on some roads needed filling. Because it was not being kept up, the blacktop edges were starting to crumble. Chairman Wiese will direct road crew to fill edging as needed with gravel.

-Adjourn: There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to adjourn at 8:07pm.
