TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday June 8, 2020

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-The Pledge of Allegiance was recited

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Edwards were present.

-First public forum-brief concerns or questions: Town resident informed town board that there was a problem with the Sandy Lane boat landing. Concrete blocks have shifted. Chairman Wiese said he would look into it.

-Agenda-There was a Steigerwaldt /Wiese motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for May 30th 2020 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$270,727.44(interest from CD of \$1252.14 not included). May deposits of \$2,666.94, withdraws of \$13,349.83, with an ending balance of \$260,044.55. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Minute's approval for the May 11, 2020 regular town meeting. There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Clerk Edwards received a call from a census worker. They will be using the town hall, Saturday, August 1st, 2020 to assist residents with registering on the 2020 census. Clerk will set open hall & set them up with WI-FI. They will be there from 8:00am to 4:30pm. They will adhere to all Covid-19 precautions.

NEW BUSINESS

-Conditional Use Application for South Pine Investments, LLC to allow an addition to an existing storage building at N10391 South Pine Road. Clerk Edwards reported sending out letters to all land owners within the required 300ft. She received 4 calls questioning what the building would be used for and were reassured that it was only for personal use so no one had any objections. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to recommend town's approval for the building. Must comply with any County regulations. All ayes. Motion carried.

Clerk reported that Northwood Forest Campground would not be renewing its Beer license, no longer selling beer in their campground store. There was a Steigerwaldt/Wiese motion to approve all 2020-2021 licenses. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Renaming part of Anglers Ave. to Bluegill Road. Due to several concerns with Police, Fire and rescue being delayed to calls within the past few years to addresses on Anglers Avenue, residents requested the road name be changed. Norn Busher of Lincoln County Land Use Dept. has been contacted and made some recommendations. Supervisor Tomaszewski requested that all land owners that will be affected by the name change, sign off on a petition approving the changes. Area resident, Flo Steckling agreed to do that. Board requested that this issue be held over to next month's meeting.

-Renewal of Town Assessors annual contract. Same price as previous year. \$5900.00 + \$25.00 for each new build. There was a motion to renew Elk Rivers Appraisals contract through May, 2023. All Ayes. Motion carried.
