

**TOWN OF KING
TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday July 13, 2020

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-The Pledge of Allegiance was recited

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Edwards were present.

-First public forum-brief concerns or questions: None

-Agenda-There was a Steigerwaldt /Tomaszewski motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to approve the vouchers. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for June 30, 2020 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$260,044.55. June deposits of \$6,328.16, withdraws of \$11,806.91, with an ending balance of \$254,565.80. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Minute's approval for the June 8, 2020 regular town meeting. There was a Wiese/ Steigerwaldt motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Clerk Edwards received an e-mail from "Local Roads Improvement Program-State/Municipal Project Agreement", \$15,215.44 allotted for road work. E-mail will be forwarded to Chairman Wiese because he had not received a copy.

OLD BUSINESS

-Renaming part of Anglers Avenue to Bluegill Road: There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to rename part of Anglers Avenue to Bluegill Road for public safety reasons. Town of King will pay for 5 or 6 new "Fire Signs" for individual properties @ \$12.50 or \$14.50 per sign depending when signs are ordered by Lincoln County plus needed replacement road signs. Treasurer Allen will contact Norm Busher of Lincoln County with this information. All Ayes, Motion Carried.

NEW BUSINESS

-Equipment Maintenance Logs for Town Equipment: Supervisor Steigerwaldt presented sample maintenance logs to instruct town employees to needed ongoing/ and year end maintenance for all town equipment. He will bring updated logs to next town meeting.

-Burning Barrel for Town Hall: A burning barrel will be installed at town hall for limited use.

-Spectrum: Chairman Wiese reported getting calls from residents that yards are still torn up from installation. It was also brought to the boards attention that lines have not been installed for service on Blue Heron Road, which was in the original agreement. Supervisor Steigerwaldt will contact Charter/Spectrum with concerns.
