

**TOWN OF KING
TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday September 14, 2020

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-The Pledge of Allegiance was recited

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Edwards were present.

-First public forum-brief concerns or questions: None

-Agenda-There was a Steigerwaldt /Tomaszewski motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for August 31, 2020 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of 285,147.14. August deposits of \$32,173.49, withdraws of \$12,448.64, with an ending balance of \$304,871.99. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Minute's approval for the August 10, 2020 regular town meeting. There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Town Chairman announced the 2021 WISLR Road Certification has been submitted.

OLD BUSINESS

- Equipment Maintenance Logs for Town Equipment-Supervisor Steigerwaldt put together 4 -3 ring binders with check lists for the maintenance of all town equipment (1 for each truck, 1 for grader & 1 for misc. town equipment with motors.) Records are to be maintained by person using that vehicle or equipment.

-Fire signs for BlueGill Road. Previously the board approved the purchase of 5 or 6 new fire signs for homes on BlueGill Road. An additional 8 signs were required to complete the project. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the additional cost of the signs of \$127.00 payable to Rent-A-Flash. All Ayes. Motion carried

NEW BUSINESS

- A Conditional use request by Rebecca & David Hilgart to allow a camping unit on the property for more than 60 days a year in a RR2 zoning district. The property is located at N9853 N. Birch Road. Clerk Edwards reported that letters were sent to all neighbors within 300ft. of property and no one objected to it. The Hilgard's were present to explain request. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the request. All Ayes. Motion carried

-Set 2021 Annual Budget workshop date-The Board agreed to meet on Wednesday, October 28, 2020 @ 5:00pm

-2020-2021 Private Road Plowing-Clerk Edwards expressed a concern that the records being kept by town drivers were not accurate enough to do billing from and presented the board with a 6 year average of what private roads were being billed. There was a discussion to charge Acorn Hollow \$300.00 and the other 5 private roads \$500.00 per season. The Board also wanted to change the contract to read that plowing in the early and late seasons will be done at the discretion of the Board due to poor gravel road conditions. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to change billing from "per plowing" to a set rate and to add the addition of limited plowing during early and late snow season to the contract. The changes to the pricing will be reviewed after the 2023/2024 season. All ayes. Motion carried.
