- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Edwards were present.
- First public forum-brief concerns or questions: None

Of those, approximately 751 are of voting age. On November 3, 2020 we had 727 registered voters, per WIS VOTE, and of those voters, 693 ballots were casted. Great turnout. Thank You!
