TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday-December 14, 2020

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt & Clerk Edwards were present. Treasurer Allen was excused
- First public forum-brief concerns or questions: None
- Agenda-There was a Steigerwaldt /Wiese motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.
- Voucher Approval: There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers. All Ayes. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for November 30, 2020 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$262,903.18. November deposits of \$10,225.14 withdraws of \$10,787.66, with an ending balance of \$262,340.66. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried. (Announced by Supervisor Tomaszewski)
- Minute's approval for the November 9, 2020 regular town meeting. There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.
- Correspondence: Clerk Edwards presented paperwork from the Town Advocacy Council for annual membership. After board reviewed, it was unanimous that the Town of King would not join for 2021.

- Employment: Supervisor Tomaszewski brought up what he felt is needed for the town roads. He made the motion to retain Gary Edwards to inspect & report needed improvements/repairs to the roads on a monthly basis during the "non snow" months and pay him at his current rate. The motion was seconded by Steigerwaldt. All ayes, motion carried.
- Liquor License for Pine Point Bar & Grill: Clerk Edwards brought the board up to date on the change of management at the bar. Current managers, Jim & Deb Roberts (RD Lincoln Holdings, LLC) have submitted a letter of intent to give up the current Liquor License assigned to Pine Point Bar & Grill, LLC as of January 1, 2021. At that time, they will remain owners of the building, but will be leasing the bar to Dena & Tom Wulf. The Wulf's are in the process of filling out the application and will get it to me ASAP. Clerk Edwards told them that the request they are submitting would need to be published in the paper for at least two weeks, then go to the town board for approval. The next town board meeting is January 11, 2021 so the January 1st deadline can not be met. Dena said she understood.
