

Approved Meeting Minutes
2020 TOWN OF KING ANNUAL MEETING
Financial Report for 2019
Meeting held via Teleconference

April 21,2020

- At 5:30pm, Chairman Wiese called the April 21,2020 annual meeting of the King Town of Supervisors and Town of King Electors to order.
- Chairman asked who was on the line attending the meeting. No response.
- Chairman Wiese announced the recital of the Pledge of Allegiance. If an American flag was not available, he reminded people to face the west.
- Roll call was taken. Terry Wiese, Chairman, Andrew Tomaszewski and Tim Steigerwaldt, Supervisors, Julie Allen, Treasurer and Donna Edwards, Clerk were present.
- Copies of the minutes from the 2019 Town of King annual meeting had been distributed to all present. There was an Allen/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the minutes. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.
- Treasurer's report was presented stating that the opening balance on hand as of January 1, 2019 was \$1,119,074.63 with the ending balance on December 31, 2019 of \$994,312.46. Treasurer & clerks records are reconciled. Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to have the 2019 treasurers' financial report entered as read. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.
- 2019 Financial Statement-Clerk Edwards presented a complete financial statement for 2019. Cash on hand as of January 1, 2019 was \$1,119,074.63. Total revenue was \$2,063,203.73 and expenses \$2,187,965.90 leaving an ending balance of \$994,312.46. Supervisor Tomaszewski questioned the background of some entries. Treasurer Allen and Clerk Edwards both offered information to try clarify the entries. There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to accept the 2019 Financial Statement into the records. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.
- Set 2021 Annual meeting date- The annual meeting is set for Tuesday, April 21, 2021 at 7:00pm at town hall.
- Board complimented Treasurer Allen for finding the CB account the netted the town \$5146.47 for 2019.
- At 5:55pm there was a Wiese/ Tomaszewski motion to adjourn the annual meeting. Motion passed unanimously with a voice vote
