

TOWN OF KING TOWN BOARD MEETING

Unapproved Minutes

Monday-April 12, 2021

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-The Pledge of Allegiance was recited

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Steigerwaldt,

Treasurer Allen & Clerk Edwards were present, Also present, newly elected Supervisor Martello and Clerk Linden.

-First public forum-brief concerns or questions: Board was told there was a “Dead End” road sign down at the intersection of Hwy D and Anglers Avenue.

-Agenda-There was a Steigerwaldt /Wiese motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Voucher Approval: There was a Tomaszewski/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the vouchers. All Ayes. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer’s report for March 31, 2021 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$340,954.72. March deposits of \$1,904.31 withdraws of \$11,248.78, with an ending balance of \$331,610.25. This balanced with the Clerk’s records and the Bank. There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Minute’s approval for the March 8, 2021 regular town meeting. There was a Steigerwaldt/Tomaszewski motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Clerk Edwards received a letter from WI. Public Works asking to be notified if the town was going to do any large road projects.

OLD BUSINESS

- Lincoln County -Shoreline Ordinance – Town of King Resolution: County Board Member & Town Treasurer Allen told the town board that a public hearing had been held at the County on 04/08/2021 and the land services committee had approved the ordinance change, however it still has to go to the full County Board. If the town has any comments, they can still be submitted to the County. The ordinance change was the county revisiting and updating their existing ordinance to bring it up to state requirements. There was a Wiese/Steigerwaldt motion to approve the County Ordinance change and create Town Resolution 2021-01 to approve shoreline zoning. All Ayes. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

- Swearing in of Elected officials from the April 6th, 2021 election and workshop. Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski and Martello, Treasurer Allen and Clerk Linden all took the oath of office and signed papers.

-Certificated of Election were given to each elected official. The notice for the WI Towns Association workshop was brought up for new & re-elected board members interested in attending the workshop. They should let clerk know so a check can be written to cover the fee. Check will be available for signing at the April 20, 2021 annual meeting.

-WI Towns association annual dues: In addition to the \$871.45 in annual dues, it was brought to the boards attention that for an additional \$50.00, they could sign up for an On Line Video Subscription. Supervisor will contact the Towns Association and question the purpose for the addition.

-Town Road: Chairman Wiese and road supervisor Edwards will be touring the roads with a representative of Lincoln County on Wednesday 4/14/2021. Chairman Wiese asked that the “roads” issue put on the April 20, 2021 annual meeting agenda.
