Public 2022 Budget Hearing and Special Meeting of Electors
And Regular Town Meeting for November 2021

Monday November 8th, 2021- Approved Meeting Minutes

- Chairman Wiese called the meetings to order at 7:00pm
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Present: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski and Martello, Treasurer Allen and Clerk Linden and 4 Town residents.

Public Budget Hearing-

Town electors were given a copy of the proposed 2022 budget summary.

- There was a Chairman Wiese motion to except and approve the Proposed 2022 Town of King budget as presented. All Ayes, No opposed. Motion carried.

Special Electors Meeting-

- Chairman Wiese motioned to approve the 2022 Highway expenditures pursuant to Section 82.03 (2) of the Wisconsin statue. All Ayes, No opposed. Motion carried

-Supervisor Martello motioned to approve the 2022 tax levy of \$107,446.00

All Ayes, No opposed. Motion carried

- Chairman Wiese then asked the residents if they had any questions or comments- None noted.

Regular Town Meeting-

First public forum-brief concerns or questions: None noted.

- Voucher Approval: There was a Wiese/Martello motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for October 2021 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$319,668.23. October deposits of \$22,948.14 withdraws of \$20,262.50 with an ending balance of \$322,353.87. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. Tomaszewski/Martello motioned to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Minute's approval for the October 11th, 2021 regular town board meeting. Tomaszewski/Martello motioned to accept the minutes into record. Motion carried.
- Correspondence: none noted.

Old Business

- Callahan Road updates- Tomaszewski noted adjoining property owner feels property lines may be off- wants to have it re-evaluated. Will update next month.
- Town equipment- Tomaszewski reported on possibilities for a new/used truck with a plow. May need a special meeting to approve possible upcoming purchase.
- Help wanted -Snowplow advertising—members agree to discontinue ads in paper at this time.

New Business

1. Roads- Shorewood Circle Property- Chairman Wiese suggested selling the property. It was brought to the boards attention that this property is being used to park campers during summer time from nearby land owners. Tomaszewski agrees to investigate further and update for next meeting.
2. Snow Plowing of Private Roads- Clerk Linden states agreement notices will be sent out this week.

3. Temporary Class B Picnic License- Lake Alice Association- Request came from Fred Brach. Chairman Wiese and Tomaszewski motion to approve the License.
