

**TOWN OF KING
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday-February 14th, 2022

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisor Martello and Tomaszewski, Treasurer Allen and Clerk Linden all present.

-First public forum-brief concerns or questions: Dave Long presented information on the Tomahawk School District Referendum that will be on the ballot for the April 5th election. Explaining the pros for passing the referendum.

-Approval of Vouchers-There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for January shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$1,011,596.49. January deposits of \$946,156.26- withdraws of \$768,147.94 with an ending balance of \$1,1,189,604.81 This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. Martello/Wiese motioned to accept into records. Motion carried.

- Approval for the January 10th 2022 regular town board meeting minutes. There were a couple of incorrect date changes needed-Wiese/Tomaszewski motioned to accept the minutes into record with the corrections made. Motion carried.

-Year to date Budget Summary- Clerk Linden advised the board that a new account needed to be created for the budget to reflect the new purchase of the Delinquent Tax property- Board agreed to move funds from Uncategorized Expenses to the new General Public Property Outlay account in order to balance budget numbers.

-Correspondence: Clerk Linden reported correspondence with the DNR in the past 2 weeks in regards to the recent sightings of a lame wolf in the area close to Pine Shore and the Town Hall. The DNR advised the public to be aware of the lame wolf and to report any further sightings to them immediately- 715-369-5221.

OLD BUSINESS

- Callahan Road Property- Tomaszewski advised he is still working on the sale of this property and will advise on any new updates at the next meet. He also advised new findings on the Shorewood Circle property as never being deeded to the Town of King, so the Town does not have authorization to go forward with any possible sale of the property.

- Purchase of Delinquent Tax Property adjacent to the King Town Hall. - Lincoln county Forestry Meeting ok'd the purchase - Waiting for Lincoln County to hear at their board meeting on February 15th, purchase is expected to go thru.

- Selling of the old Truck "as is"- Several people have shown interest in buying the truck, it was determined that the Town will need to post notice of the sale and possible closed bidding. Chairman Wiese advised they will get the truck ready for sale and advise the next steps for bids at the March meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

- ARPA Final Ruling from the US Treasury was received. Clerk Linden advised the first financial reporting for the Town is due on April 30th. The Board members will investigate further and look at all possible uses and discuss again at the next meeting.
