2021 TOWN OF KING ANNUAL MEETING  
Financial Report for 2020  
Meeting held at King Hall

April 20,2021

- At 5:30pm, Chairman Wiese called the April 20,2021 annual meeting of the King Town of Supervisors and Town of King Electors to order.
- Chairman Terry Wiese, Supervisors- Andrew Tomaszewski and Mark Martello, Julie Allen Treasurer and Georgene Linden Clerk, all present.
- Chairman Wiese announced the recital of the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Copies of the minutes from the 2020 Town of King Annual meeting were distributed to all present. Motion was made to approve- and passed unanimously.
- Treasurer Allen's report was presented stating that the opening balance on hand as of January 1, 2020 was \$994,312.46 with the ending balance on December 31, 2020 of \$927,387.32. Treasurer & clerks records are reconciled. Tomaszewski/Wiese motioned to have the 2020 treasurers' financial report entered as read. Motion passed unanimously.
- Clerk Linden presented the financial statement for 2020. Cash on hand as of January 1, 2020 was \$927,387.32. Total revenue was \$2,113,137.07 and total expenses \$2,180,062.21 leaving an ending balance of \$927,387.32. There was a Wiese/Martello motion to have the 2020 Financial Statement entered as read. Motion passed unanimously.
- Supervisor Tomaszewski presented information on selling of non-used Town Properties- specifically Pickerel Lake parcel off of Callahan Rd. Proposal was made to further investigate the property value and determine the towns option to sell. Motion was made to go forward and to discuss further at May's monthly meeting. Motion passed unanimously.
- Chairman Wiese opened discussion on Town Roads and what options there are to fix the 5-6 roads in need of repair with the money on hand. Members agree to go forward with obtaining bids for crack sealing and additional repairs. Motion was made to further discuss at the Town Hall meeting in May 2021. Motion passed unanimously.
- Discussion started on wages for newly elected clerks and treasurers for the transition period after elections. - It was determined that changes could only be made by budget process at the next 2022 Annual Budget meeting. Members agree to revisit details at later date.
- Board set 2022 Annual meeting date- for Tuesday, April 19, 2022 at 5:30pm at town hall, with no publications needed.
- At 6:08pm there was a Wiese/ Tomaszewski motion to adjourn the annual meeting. Motion passed unanimously.
