

**TOWN OF KING  
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday-March 14th, 2022

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisor Martello and Tomaszewski, Treasurer Allen and Clerk Linden all present.
- First public forum-brief concerns or questions: none noted.
- Approval of Vouchers-There was a Tomaszewski/Martello motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for February shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$1,189,604.81. January deposits of \$82,643.47- withdraws of \$963,817.82 with an ending balance of \$308,430.46. This balanced with the Banks statement and the Clerks records. Tomaszewski/Martello motioned to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Approval for the February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022 regular town board meeting minutes. There was a Wiese/Martello motion to accept meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.
- Year to date Budget Summary- Clerk Linden pointed out the numbers for real estate taxes showed to be off - Treasurer Allen agreed to look into it further on her end. Will update again for next month.
- Correspondence: Clerk Linden reported correspondence from Foleys Tree Services, needing special permits for the new 4axle crane they recently purchased. Request for permits would be as needed after the spring restrictions are off. Foleys must obtain permission prior to use on any Town road.
- Spring weight limits posted/on as of March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

OLD BUSINESS

- Callahan Road Property- Tomaszewski advised the contract with the Realtor has expired – made decision to sign up for another 6 months. Will update again.
- Purchase of Delinquent Tax Property adjacent to the King Town Hall. – Lincoln county ok'd the purchase and documents/receipt of payment has been received.
- Selling of the old Truck- Per Tomaszewski, the ad has been placed in the Tomahawk Leader. We will be accepting closed bids up until April 6<sup>th</sup>, they will be opened on the April 11<sup>th</sup> Regular Town Meeting. Bids must be received in a sealed envelope marked as "Truck Bid".
- Truck inspection is by appointment only 715-453-4683.

NEW BUSINESS

- April 5<sup>th</sup> Election- Clerk Linden advised the board that extra poll workers will be needed for all future elections for 2022, as well as another poll booth. Tomaszewski made the motion to swearing in 2 more additional poll workers- with possible help from high school students who fit criteria. Chairman Wiese also made motion to purchase a new portable ADA Polling Booth for the April election. Each motion carried. Updates on the new polling booth will be presented at the April 11<sup>th</sup> Town Meeting, for board to decide on possibly eliminating the existing wooden poll booths, and replacing them all with new booths.
- Employee Wages—Chairman Wiese recommend paying the regular town employees- plow driver wages- when they are required to help plow town roads. Board agreed to put this into effect immediately as needed.
