

**TOWN OF KING
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday-April 11th, 2022

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisor Martello and Tomaszewski, Treasurer Allen and Clerk Linden all present.
- First public forum-brief concerns or questions: Discussion was noted about nuisance property on Mable Highlands Frontage Rd- Board agreed that The Town of King will submit a formal complaint to Lincoln County to help resolve ordinance compliance.
- Approval of Vouchers-There was a Tomaszewski/Martello motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for March shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$308,430.46 deposits of \$552.32- withdraws of \$9,516.19 with an ending balance of \$299,466.59. This balanced with the Banks statement and the Clerks records. Tomaszewski/Martello motioned to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Approval for the March 14th, 2022 regular town board meeting minutes. There was a Wiese/Martello motion to accept meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.
- Year to date Budget Summary- Clerk Linden reported new account created for financial services -Treasurer Allen will advise of any discrepancies on budget summary at next meeting.
- Correspondence: none noted.

OLD BUSINESS

- Selling of the old Truck- 9 closed bids were opened with the winning bid at \$8600.
- Election/new poll booth- Clerk Linden advised how the new ADA booth worked on election day- the Board was in agreement to purchase 4 more booths to replace the old units with funding from ARPA funds.

NEW BUSINESS

- ARPA- Clerk Linden advised she will be filing the first reporting to US Treasury - due by April 30th. She also requested that all board members help further investigate the towns options to use the funds. All were in agreement and will update again at future meetings.
- Amendment of the Official Lincoln County Zoning (rezoning) Ordinance was presented – Board approved the ordinance amendment and the signed copy will be sent to Lincoln County Land Services Committee.
- Training for Board of Review- Chairman Wiese advised he will attend the yearly training for 2022 BOR.
- Adjourn: There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to adjourn at 7:51pm.
