

**TOWN OF KING
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday-May 9th, 2022

-Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM

-The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

-Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisor Martello and Tomaszewski, Treasurer Allen and Clerk Linden all present.

-First public forum-brief concerns or questions: Supervisor Tomaszewski reported an update on the Mable Highlands Frontage Rd property- a formal complaint was made by the Town of King directly with the Lincoln Cty Land Services Director. The property owners have until the end of June to clean up the property before fines are issued or further action is taken.

Also noted—Repairs are expected to be made to the Surewood Boat Landing that had damage over the winter. Will address the issue at future meetings if need be.

-Approval of Vouchers-There was a Tomaszewski/Martello motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.

- Approval for the April 11th regular town board meeting minutes. There was a Wiese/Martello motion to accept meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.

-The Treasurer's report for April- shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$299,466.59 deposits of \$27,049.08- withdraws of \$17,583.80 with an ending balance of \$308,931.87. This balanced with the Banks statement. The Clerks records matched except a discrepancy of \$61.91 for a voided check.

Tomaszewski/Martello motioned to accept into records. Motion carried.

-Correspondence: Clerk Linden received notice that the Town must update our Quickbooks software to the 2022 version, with a new annual subscription instead of every 3 years. The new version will be installed and she will investigate the Towns options regarding the Payroll subscription.

OLD BUSINESS

- Monies were received for the selling of the old truck- Board members agree to deposit in the General Fund to be allocated to Town Equipment Account.

NEW BUSINESS

- Treasurer Allen presented information regarding a Broadband Advisory Committee that was created to help support the Lincoln County broadband efforts. She will advise more information to the Town of King as progress is being made.

- ARPA- Clerk Linden advised completing the first ARPA Funds Compliance Report with US Treasury.
