

**TOWN OF KING
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday-August 8th, 2022

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski and Martello, Treasurer Allen, and Clerk Linden all present.
- First public forum-brief concerns or questions: Property owners from Spring Creek Rd were present and voiced concerns about the increased traffic by the Spring Creek and Lily Lake Rd intersections. All Board members agree to replacing the now "Yield/Right Turn" sign(s) to a "STOP" sign with a "Right Turn No Stop", and Stop Ahead with flags to alert drivers in the area of the new signage.
- Approval of Vouchers- There was a Wiese/ Martello motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for May- shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$350,602.60 deposits of \$31,302.03- withdraws of \$7,881.61 with an ending balance of \$374,023.02. This balanced with the Banks statement and the clerk's records. Tomaszewski / Martello motioned to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Approval for the July 11th, 2022 regular town board meeting minutes. There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.
- Correspondence: Chairman Wiese advised of the survey received from Lincoln County Emergency Management. The survey is asking for input from all municipalities in the county on the biggest concerns for natural disaster in our area. Supervisor Tomaszewski will submit the form back to Lincoln County.

OLD BUSINESS

- Mable Highlands Frontage Rd property updates- Tomaszewski reported new conversation with Mike Huth from Lincoln County. He stated the owner is in process of starting cleanup and getting licenses/registrations for properly moving some of the vehicles left on the property. He also stated further investigation is being done in regards to the back taxes owed on the property. Will update again next month.
- Town Roads- Chairman Wiese reported the road work for the Town's roads is in progress and estimates most projects to be finished by end of August.
- Broadband Advisory Committee-updates. Treasurer Allen did not have any new updates at this time. Ken Wickham was present and urges everyone in the Township to complete the Internet Speed Test so the county can get accurate mapping of the areas with little to no internet access.
- ARPA Funds – Treasurer Allen reported moving the ARPA funds and Super Fund monies into a Money Market Account, -no other updates were noted at this time.

NEW BUSINESS

- New Liquor License- Sale of Guppies Lakeside Grill to Robert Everts- Rivers Edge. There was a Wiese Martello motion to ok the new license pending the sale of the property on August 25th. Motion Carried.
- Comments: any items not requiring Board action; agenda items for the next Board meeting.- none noted.
- Adjourn: There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to adjourn at 7:35pm.
