

**TOWN OF KING  
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday-September 12th, 2022

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski and Martello, Treasurer Allen, and Clerk Linden all present.
- First Public forum- brief concerns, - A Property owner was present voicing concerns/ asking if the speed limit could be reduced on Hwy A by the bridge between Bottoms Up and Rivers Edge. Tomaszewski reported he will be contacting the Lincoln County Hwy Commissioner to approve a 45mph speed limit for this area.  
Another property owner advised the board of a large area off Spring Creek and Terry Road where the road is damaged with washout and deep cracks in the pavement -Chairman Wiese stated they will be checking the area and will patch what can be patched or will advise Lincoln County that repairs are needed.
- Approval of Vouchers- There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for August- shows an opening balance at Crossbridge Community Bank of \$374,023.02, deposits of \$76,133.14- withdraws of \$68,621.91, with an ending balance of \$381,534.25. This balanced with the Banks statement and the clerk's records.  
Tomaszewski / Wiese motioned to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Approval for the August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022 regular town board meeting minutes. There was a Wiese/Martello motion to accept meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.
- Approval for the August 25<sup>th</sup> Special Town Meeting Minutes- There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to approve the minutes -motion carried. Further discussion was presented to inform the people present of what will be on the ballot as a referendum question for the November 8<sup>th</sup> Election.
- Correspondence. - Supervisor Tomaszewski- reported being notified by the Lake Alice Association in regards to putting up a new longer boat dock on the Birch Rd landing area. Chairman Wiese- reported receiving the WISLR Local Road Certification Packet. -the Town of King must submit this to the WisDOT by October 14<sup>th</sup>, in order to be eligible for General Transportation Aids for 2023.

OLD BUSINESS

- Mable Highlands Frontage Rd property updates- The owner of this property was present to let the town board members know they have started working to clean up the property.
- Town Roads- Chairman Wiese reported road work on E&W River Roads and Shady Shore have been completed.
- ARPA Updates- Tomaszewski will report on new ARPA updates after attending the Wisconsin Towns Association Convention in October.

## NEW BUSINESS

- Conditional Use Permit Request- for chicken coop on the property of W4761 Mabel Frontage Rd. – Decision was made to wait for the Staff Report from Lincoln County to hear their recommendations. One property owner was present to voice concerns and disapproval of the CUP request. Members will make final decision at the October 11<sup>th</sup>, Town Meeting.
- Budget Planning for 2023- Board Members agree to have the Budget Workshop Meeting October 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm to create final draft for 2023.
- Comments: any items not requiring Board action; agenda items for the next Board meeting- none noted.
- Adjourn: There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to adjourn at 7:50pm.
