

**TOWN OF KING
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Monday-November 14th, 2022 - Approved Minutes

- Chairman Wiese called the Regular Town Board meeting to order after completing the Budget Hearing and Special Electors meeting.
- First Public forum- brief concerns- Discussion was brought up in regards to the property on Mable Highlands Frontage Rd, with several people stating that little to no progress seems to have been made at this point. Supervisor Tomaszewski reported that Lincoln County is continuing their efforts with the property owner directly, and also advised the property will be in process of foreclosure due to back taxes.
- Approval of Vouchers- There was a Wiese/Martello motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- Approval for the October 10th, 2022 regular town board meeting minutes. There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to accept meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for October- shows an opening balance at Crossbridge Community Bank of \$367,938.86, deposits of \$157,894.52- withdraws of \$264,957.52, with an ending balance of \$260,875.86. This balanced with the Banks statement and the clerk's records. Chairman Wiese motioned to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Correspondence. -Clerk Linden reported receiving an email from the Town of Wilson Clerk asking all LC municipalities to be involved in a Solid Waste and Recycling Collection project. Each township provided their information and it was compiled into a spreadsheet showing the comparison of costs. The Board members agreed to look closer at the information provided to ensure the Town of King is not paying too much.

OLD BUSINESS

- ARPA Updates- Tomaszewski reported on new information he obtained at the WTA convention. He was advised that one of the best uses for the ARPA funds will be to use it towards salary payroll. The budgeted amounts from Salaries of Board Members would then be moved to whatever account is needed. This will provide a much cleaner/easier way of reporting to US Treasury and ensure we're able to use the monies before the deadline expires.

NEW BUSINESS

- The 2022-23 Snow Plowing of Private Rd contracts have been sent out and received back.
- Supervisor Tomaszewski reported on the possible purchase of a hydraulic Road Groomer attachment that can be pulled behind the new truck purchased last year for the cost of \$18,000. He will update next month with more information.
- Lincoln Cty Zoning Ordinance – board members agreed and signed to accept the text amendment change to the Accessory Structure- Conditional Use- Chapter 17 Zoning ordinance.
- 2022 General Election Results- Clerk Linden reported a total of 607 votes cast on election day. And also reported the results for the Referendum question being that the Clerks position will remain an elected position. Thank you to everyone who voted!
