

**TOWN OF KING  
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

**Approved Minutes- Monday-Feb 13th, 2023**

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisor Tomaszewski, Supervisor Martello, Treasurer Allen, and Clerk Linden all present.
- First Public forum-brief concerns. None noted.
- Approval of Vouchers- There was a Tomaszewski/Martello motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for January- shows an opening balance at Crossbridge Community Bank of \$1,028,915.82, deposits of \$1,152,867.05- withdraws of \$758,372.74, with an ending balance of \$1,424,410.13. This balanced with the Banks statement and the clerk's records. There was a Wiese/Martello motion to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Approval for the January 9th, 2023 regular town board meeting minutes-There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.
- Correspondence. -none noted.

**OLD BUSINESS**

- Town Road Equipment Updates- delivery of the new grooming attachment is on schedule for April.
- 2023 Fire Contract with City of Tomahawk Updates- Chairman Wiese and Supervisor Tomaszewski reported attending the meeting in Tomahawk on February 1<sup>st</sup>. They were not successful in delaying the contract increase of over \$16,000 per year and stated the town will be forced to use ARPA monies to fund the increase for 2023, and raise the Levy Limit for future years. Levy Limit increase procedures will take place later in the year.

**NEW BUSINESS**

- New Assessor Contract – Board members reviewed the projected rate increases from Elk River Appraisals for the years 2024 thru 2026. The board agreed that more information was needed- Supervisor Tomaszewski will follow up and get more details before the next town meeting. The board also agreed to the dates of May 6<sup>th</sup> for Open Book and May 13<sup>th</sup> for the BOR with Chairman Wiese agreeing to do the training for BOR.
- Lincoln County Zoning Ordinance Text Revision- Section 17.2.100 – This revision will possibly change the existing text for certain land uses which previously required CUP permits, to be “permitted” going forward. The board discussed further, and resolved to approve the proposed text change.
- CUP Request from Sam Duncan- to allow for a camping unit to be used on his property for more than 60 days. After discussion, the board wishes to limit the time frame in which the camper is going to be used on the property- The towns recommendations will be sent to Lincoln County Zoning where they are scheduled to make their final decision at the next hearing on March 9<sup>th</sup>.
- Comments: any items not requiring Board action; none noted.
- Adjourn: There was a Wiese motion to adjourn at 7:44 pm.
