

**TOWN OF KING  
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

**Approved Minutes- Monday-March 13th, 2023**

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisor Tomaszewski, Supervisor Martello, Treasurer Allen, and Clerk Linden all present.
- First Public forum-brief concerns. None noted.
- Approval of Vouchers- There was a Wiese/Martello motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for February- shows an opening balance at Crossbridge Community Bank of \$1,424,410.13, deposits of \$176,217.57- withdraws of \$1,251,262.99, with an ending balance of \$349,364.71. This balanced with the Banks statement and the clerk's records. There was a Tomaszewski/Martello motion to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Approval for the February 13th, 2023 regular town board meeting minutes-There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to accept meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.
- Correspondence. -Chairman Wiese noted the Town Roads weight restrictions will go into effect as of March 15<sup>th</sup> at noon.

**OLD BUSINESS**

- Broadband Committee updates- Ken Wickham was present to discuss updates from the Lincoln County Broadband Committee. He stated during the next few months Charter Communications will begin construction of a project to expand and provide fiber optic broadband service throughout a large portion of underserved areas in Lincoln County with the help of local planning grants. He mentioned they are reaching out to all townships in the county to gather more information and will be updating again as more information becomes available.
- 2023 Fire Contract with City of Tomahawk Updates- A check for the budgeted amount of \$24,000 was paid to City of Tomahawk, with remaining balance due by EOY. It was determined the remaining balance will be paid from the Towns ARPA funds for this year- with future years funded by a Levy Limit increase that will be discussed at a special town meeting coming up later in the year.
- Assessor Contract updates- Tomaszewski checked with the other townships in the area to see how the TOK compares with others for assessor fees/contracts. His findings confirmed that most all townships are paying more. The board members agree that it is best to stay with Elk River Appraisals for the next 3 year contract term 2024-2026. This is a total amount of \$37,400 for external Revaluations of all properties. The town is looking at the possibility of a yearly payment plan instead of a one-time payment. This will also be discussed further with Levy Limit increase later this year.
