

**TOWN OF KING
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes- Monday-April 10th, 2023

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisor Tomaszewski, Supervisor Martello, Treasurer Allen, and Clerk Linden all present.
- First Public forum-brief concerns. Chairman Wiese put a special Thank you out to all the towns employees that did the extra work to make sure our roads were cleaned up as quickly as possible after the last record snow fall on April 1st.
- Approval of Vouchers- There was a Tomaszewski/Martello motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for March- shows an opening balance at Crossbridge Community Bank of \$349,364.71, deposits of \$598.25- withdraws of \$35,405.97, with an ending balance of \$314,556.99. This balanced with the Banks statement and the clerk's records. There was a Wiese/Martello motion to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Approval for the March 13, 2023 regular town board meeting minutes-There was a Tomaszewski/Martello motion to accept meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.
- Correspondence. -Chairman Wiese received notice from JJ's Brush Cutting service of increase in rates for 2023- plans to look into getting rates from other vendors but feel JJ's provides the best rates for our area.

OLD BUSINESS

- Town Road Updates- Chainman Wiese noted many roads in the area have a lot of soft spots and pot holes -all agree they cannot be repaired properly until the snow melts and roads dry up.

NEW BUSINESS

- Swearing in of newly elected Town Officers – Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski and Dyer, Treasurer Allen and Clerk Linden all took the oath and received their Certificates of Election.
- Wisconsin Towns Association Annual Dues- Board members agree on the benefits that WTA provides and agree to pay the increase for dues and continue to receive monthly flyers.
- Delinquent Personal Property Taxes- Treasure Allen reported sending 5 collection notices out this year. All but one property owner has yet to send payment.
- Possible Clean Sweep/Appliance Recycling Day—Tentative dates were set for July 15th and 16th - with final details to be determined at the Annual Town Meeting to be held on April 18th at 5:30pm. Any Town Electors present at that meeting will be able to give their input at that time.
- Comments: any items not requiring Board action; none noted.
- Adjourn: There was a Wiese motion to adjourn at 7:23 pm.
