

**TOWN OF KING
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Unapproved Minutes- Monday-May 8th, 2023

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisor Tomaszewski, Supervisor Dyer, Treasurer Allen, and Clerk Linden all present.
- First Public forum-brief concerns. – There was a town elector present asking for updates on internet service for parts of the town that have little to no internet availability. Ken Wickham the Chairman for the Lincoln Cty Broadband Committee was present and helped answer their questions directly.
- Approval of Vouchers- There was a Tomaszewski/Dyer motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer’s report for April- shows an opening balance at Crossbridge Community Bank of \$314,556.99, deposits of \$29,113.43- withdraws of \$39,309.65, with an ending balance of \$304,360.77. This balanced with the Banks statement and the clerk’s records. There was a Wiese/Dyer motion to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Approval for the April 8th, 2023 regular town board meeting minutes-There was a Wiese/Dyer motion to accept meeting minutes as written. Motion carried.
- Correspondence. -Chairman Wiese received notice from WISLR- in regards to radar/grading the town’s road surfaces which will be completed later in the year.

OLD BUSINESS

- Assessor Contract- Tomaszewski further explained that all properties in the township must be Revaluated starting in 2024. The extra costs for the revaluation will be split over the next 4 years instead of 3 so not to affect the budget as much. It was also noted that the Board of Review for next year will be in August instead of May.
- Recycling Days- for large recycable items is set for July 15th and 16th at the Town Hall. Flyers with details will be posted and handed out during normal recycling hours prior to July 15th.
- New Groomer Delivery- Supervisor Tomaszewski reported taking delivery of the new attachment and discussed possible ways to secure it at the Town Hall property.

NEW BUSINESS

- Sandy Lane Boat Dock- Repairs have been made to the Sandy Lane boat dock but it was determined that it may need to be replaced in the future- board will be reaching out to the Lake Alice Association as well.
- Comments: any items not requiring Board action; Chairman Wiese reported the possibility to get our Grader and other road equipment refurbished- Supervisor Dyer will help to inspect the equipment and determine if its cost effective to refurbish. Treasurer Allen suggested the possibility to having someone inspect the roads to evaluate any repairs needed prior to the Levy Limit meeting in the fall. Board members agree to have the roads inspected and will follow up.
- Adjourn: There was a Wiese motion to adjourn at 7:30 pm.
